

BRADSHAW MOUNTAIN VIEW WATER CUSTOMER NOTICE

STAGE 2 CURTAILMENT

The Arizona Corporation Commission (Commission) authorized Bradshaw Mountain View Water (Company) to curtail water usage under certain conditions. A copy of the curtailment plan is available upon request by calling 520-623-5172.

There are 4 stages in the water curtailment plan described as follows:

- Stage 1 – no known issues;
- Stage 2 – water production is less than 80% of capacity for 48 hours;
- Stage 3 - water production is less than 50% of capacity for 24 hours; and
- Stage 4 – water production is less than 25% of capacity for 12 hours.

In addition, depending upon water supply and demand, stages 2, 3 or 4 may be implemented if the Company has identified issues such as a steadily declining water table, increased draw down threatening pump operations, or poor water production, creating a reasonable belief the Company will be unable to meet anticipated water demand on a sustained basis.

Current Issue - Water production has dropped below 80% due to a lack of water in the aquifer. The Company has observed a steadily declining water table and increased drawdown.

Curtailment Stage 2 – The Company requests its customers to **voluntarily** employ water conservation measures to reduce water consumption by approximately 50%. The Company requests that you conserve water by eliminating non-essential water use and water landscaping as follows:

- If your address ends in an even number, then water on Monday and Thursday;
- If your address end in an odd number, then water on Tuesday and Friday;
- Do not water landscaping on weekends;
- Do not use water for outdoor cleaning or washing vehicles;
- Avoid or limit recreational and aesthetic use of water such as pools, spas, and fountains;
- Do not use of water for misting systems; and
- Identify and repair any leaking kitchen and bathroom fixtures.
