

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

PRECAUTIONARY BOIL NOTICE UPDATE:

Joshua Valley Utility Company issued a precautionary boil notice on 08/30/2026 for the north side of Joshua Valley Water. This encompasses the area between Silver Creek Drive and Diamond Drive only.

Until the utility has informed you that the water is safe to drink, we advise you to use bottled water OR to boil all tap water before consumption/use. ORIGINAL NOTICE:

Due to a mainline break on 08/30/2026, Joshua Valley Utility Company has issued a precautionary boil notice. As a precaution, we advise you to either utilize bottled water or boil your tap water for a minimum of 3 minutes before using it for drinking or preparing food that is not otherwise cooked.

Inadequately treated water may contain disease-causing organisms. These organisms include bacteria, viruses, and parasites which can cause symptoms such as nausea, cramps, diarrhea, and associated headaches. These symptoms, however, are not caused only by organisms in drinking water, but also by other factors. If you experience any of these symptoms and persist, you may want to seek medical advice.

What is being done:

We are continuing to make repairs to the system, which includes adding chlorine to disinfect the water. We are working with our Certified Drinking Water Operator to make the repairs as quickly as possible.

Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
